During these uncertain times it is helpful to "go back to basics" and to consider what Hashem wants from us. The Mishna in Pirkei Avos famously tells us that the world survives on three pillars. On Torah, Avoda and Gemilus Chassadim. Our community is well known for Gemilus Chassadim and no doubt everyone can and will play their part in supporting one another and caring for those who need help, in whatever form. We can each work on our Avoda by improving our tefillah, notwithstanding this must be done without the enhanced benefit of davening in a minyan, for now.

The third pillar is the learning of Torah. We must be mindful of the fact that Pesach is approaching. As is customary at this time of the year – in addition to the physical preparations - we have to remind ourselves of the halachos of Pesach too. As we adjust to changed circumstances, people may struggle to concentrate on formal learning for extended periods of time. To address this, I propose recording a "bitesize" daily podcast of 3-5 minutes with a refresher / overview of some of the halachos pertaining to Pesach preparations, the seder and the mitzvos of the Yom Tov. The recordings will be based on an excellent compendium of Hilchos Pesach written by Rabbi Dovid Ribiat.

Once a day, it is planned to send it out on a broadcast by WhatsApp
